

We prepare young people with significant disabilities for success in competitive integrated employment.

Project SEARCH is a unique, business-led, one-year employment preparation program that takes place entirely at the workplace, serving young people (18-21) with intellectual and developmental disabilities in their last year of high school.

Project SEARCH combines real-life work experience with training in employability and independent living skills helping young people with disabilities make successful transitions to productive adult life.

After an initial orientation, a skills assessment, and familiarization within the business environment, our interns develop a career plan that guides the internship selection process and individualized job search.

Through a series of three targeted internships at a host site, interns acquire competitive, marketable, & transferable skills; while also building communication, teamwork, and problem-solving skills.

Once interns master these core skills, additional skills are layered to improve marketability.

The program concludes with interns receiving a job of their choice.
